As I am writing this, I am listening to the Podcast that our Year 6/7 students created as part of their extension opportunity at South Learning Centre [Year 6/7 Podcast](#). The podcast highlights many of the awesome aspects of our kura - our Student Council, our learning opportunities, our local history and a couple of interviews with both long standing stunning staff members, Robyn, Karen G and Caroline and new staff member, Joseph. A huge shout out to Kyla, Adalee, Arlia, Hannah, Emma, Coby, Louie, Sam, Jack R, Catalina, Khloe, Robbie for their awesome mahi / work!.

Some other highlights from this term from our staff include:

- Strum, Strike, Blow was a really fantastic event and the students had a blast!
- Ki-o-rahi tournament - we won the Te Kotahitanga Award for demonstrating unity through cooperation and teamwork.
- The volleyball net being put out everyday on the top field and students learning the proper rules and having great rallies
- Year 3/4 Kapa Haka - our group of kids have put together a bracket for Tūhono in Term 4.
- Big Breakfast was an awesome opportunity to connect with whānau and people of our community - thanks to Home and School for leading this
- Celebrating Te Wiki o te reo Māori
- Lit Quiz - our 'hand drawn' banner won the top award; our teams came 3rd and 6th out of 20 teams
- Watching our 'scobys' grow. We gave them tea at the start of the term and have seen them slowly turn into kombucha. They are called 'Teay' and 'Shevaun' and checking in with them has been a highlight for the tamariki each day!
- Seeing students progress with pronouncing words, sounding out and becoming confident readers all round.
- Rock Quest - loved seeing our students perform on the big stage and showcase their talents
- Pasifika performance - our students continuing to celebrate their culture - loud and proud
- Walking up Rāpaki track with the Year 5-6 team. The kids were amazing and so supportive of one another. Every single child made it up.
- Science Fun - we love the science boxes; The Bug Man came to visit; a lamb came to visit; we grew crystals and learned about magnets. We harvested from the garden and cooked with the amazing vegetables we grew. Yum! We love science!
- Cricket coaching sessions



- The visiting 'Play' - Treasure Island and watching the dress rehearsal of Moana at St Marks
- Our class reward time with Room 19 after filling our 'Aroha jar' Lots of fun games organised by our big buddies.
- Student engagement with reading and positive progress. One student commented she can now help other family members read and can read street signs and billboards.

Uniform Dress:

Students are expected to take pride in their appearance.

- Please see <http://www.opawa.school.nz/uniform.html> for the full Ōpāwa School uniform.
- The uniform should be clean, tidy and named.
- **Only** the long sleeved Ōpāwa School undergarment (gunmetal grey) should be visible under the Ōpāwa polo shirt.
- Socks/tights - plain navy, black or white.
- Shoes must be black, brown or predominantly white trainers, leather shoes or sandals.
- School sun hats must be worn in Terms 1 and 4. Plain black or beige bucket/wide brimmed hat or cap.
- No nail polish and/or makeup to be worn at school.
- Coloured hair is not appropriate.
- Hair accessories: plain black, navy or orange headbands, ties, ribbons, bows or clips. Ties, ribbons, bows or clips to be no longer than 8cm in diameter.
- Drawing on skin and tattoo transfers are not acceptable.
- One piece swimming togs are recommended.
- No jewellery should be worn except watches and ear studs or sleepers. No other earrings. Any other jewellery, including rings and necklaces can be a safety hazard and are not to be worn at school. All jewellery must be removed for sport. Variations due to cultural or religious beliefs are allowed on written request from parents/caregivers.



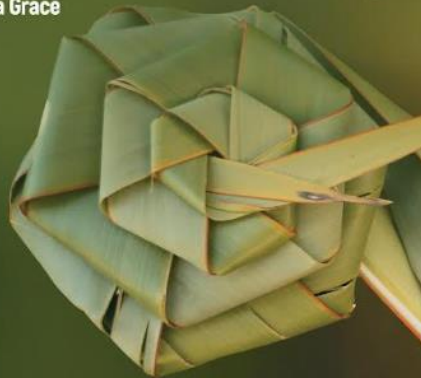
