WAINUI PARK CAMP NOTICE

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This year our Year 5/6 camp will be held at Wainui Park in week 10 of Term 3. Wainui Park offers students a chance to experience ocean based activities such as Sea Kayaking, whilst still providing the outdoor living and survival skills that previous camps at this year level have offered. All of the Year 5 and 6 students will attend camp together which will allow students across the classes to enjoy a shared experience.

All costs have been calculated on full participation of all Year 5 and 6 students.

Total camp cost is \$220 per student. Thank you to those families who have already paid in full.

A second instalment of \$100 is now due.

This will leave a third and final payment of \$70, to be paid before week five of term 3.

There are 19 school weeks remaining until camp (plus 4 weeks holiday). You can pay this to the office by cheque or eftpos, or you can pay by direct credit/internet banking. Please quote your child's name and room number. *Bank account number* 12-3147-0419969-00
