Why Volunteer?

Actions always speak louder than words. When children see you showing that you care about education, they care too. They also learn the value of helping others.

When you sign up for Give Me 5...

- You offer to give at least 5 hours of your time to help our school during the year.
- We give you a choice of many ways to volunteer for our school.
- You tell us how you'd like to be involved and how you can be contacted.
- You enjoy seeing the smile on your child's face when they see you helping out at school.

What counts as volunteering?

Doing anything that helps your child and our school counts towards your Give Me 5 hours. Some activities can be done at home, or outside of school hours, if you are not able to come into school. Some examples are:

- Helping in the classroom or making resources for a teacher
- Helping get children to and from school safely by supervising road patrol
- Helping in the library
- Becoming a buddy reader
- Coaching a sports team
- Lending a hand at a school event or working bee
- Being parent help for a class trip
