This year our Year 5/6 camp will be held at Woodend Christian Camp in Week 2 of Term 4 (Monday 16th - Wednesday 18th October). Woodend offers students a chance to experience a range of activities that previous camps at this year level have offered. All of the Year 5 and 6 students will attend camp together which will allow students across the classes to enjoy a shared experience.

All costs have been calculated on full participation of all Year 5 and 6 students.
Total camp cost is \$180 per student.
